10. Preparation Instructions		
10.1 <u>Initial Drawings:</u>		
10.1.1 Drawings and associated lists shall be prepared in accordance with DOD-STD-100.		
10.1.2 The selection of the specific types and number of drawings which best present the Seller's equipment is the responsibility of the Seller unless specific direction is provided by the Buyer. The Seller's CAGE Code shall appear on each drawing.		
10.2 <u>Final Drawings:</u>		
10.2.1 Changes: Any changes to initial drawings resulting from design development, Buyer's comments or other reasons shall be incorporated and the drawings distributed as final drawings.		
10.2.2 Records: The Seller shall maintain a reproducible copy of each drawing and of each revision to that drawing submitted to the Buyer. The drawing file shall be available for Buyer's inspection.		
(a) The reproducibles of drawings shall be suitable for microfilming, having legibility and contrast so that every line, number, letter and character will be clearly legible on a fifth generation copy.		
(b) Vellum reproducibles shall be rolled. Bond paper drawings shall be flat.		
10.3 <u>Drawing Media:</u>		
10.3.1 Copies: Copies shall be blue-line (B/L) prints folded individually in accordion pleated form to an 8-1/2" by 11" rectangle with the title block exposed in the lower right hand corner.		
10.3.2 <u>Reproducibles:</u>		
(a) Reproducibles shall be on vellum in accordance with MIL-D-5480, Type II, Class 2. 8-1/2" by 11" drawings may be on bond paper.		
(b) The reproducibles of drawings shall be suitable for microfilming, having legibility and contrast so that every line, number, letter and character will be clearly legible on a fifth generation copy.		
(c) Vellum reproducibles shall be rolled. Bond paper drawings shall be flat.
